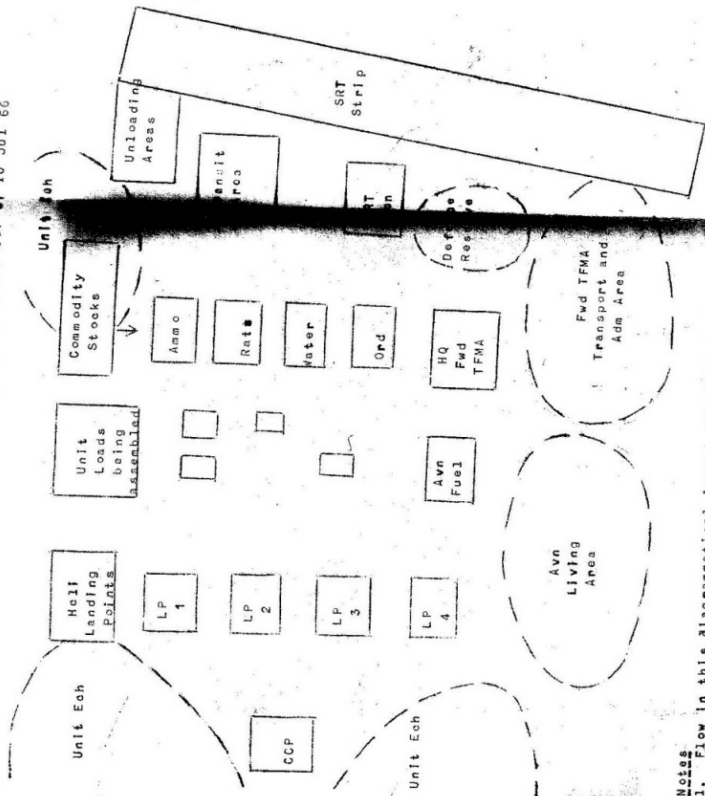

- * These items should not be sent in clear by insecure means.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE COMPLETION OF THIS FORM

- ITEM 1. Unit and appointment of requestor.
- ITEM 2. Describe target and include any special target identification features. Give map reference and map sheet.
- ITEM 3. Explain in detail the purpose of the request or the results desired. Avoid general or stereotyped phrases such as "suspected VC activity". Explain what is suspected and why.
- ITEM 4. If the request is for photo intelligence do not request prints unless they are essential as it may well delay the completion of the mission.
- ITEM 5. If prints are required state type eg. vertical, oblique.
- ITEM 6. State scale desired based on guide -
1:3000 or large 1:6000. - 1:10000 1:20000 or smaller.
1:3000 - 1:6000 1:10000 - 1:20000
- ITEM 7. If prior coverage is acceptable when ordering prints state "YES" and how recent the coverage must be to meet the requestor's requirement. For example: "YES - 30 days"
- ITEM 8. State number of copies required and where they are to be delivered.
- ITEM 9. Priorities are subject to review by higher HQ. Those in use are:
- (a) 1 -X (Immediate) Restricted to Major Field Commanders only.
- (b) Priority 1 - To exploit major targets of opportunity.
- (c) Priority 2 - In support of ops beginning within 48 hours of the requested time over target.

(d) Priority 3 - In support of operational planning and surveillance of activities capable of posing a future threat.

(e) Priority 4 - In support of routine planning to meet administrative or logistical requirements. Terrain studies; map supplements; surveillance of units or activities capable of limited interference with the mission; basic cover.
