MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

RETWEEN

4 RAR (CDO) AND THE 4 RAR MUSEUM FOUNDATION

General

 This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) outlines the agreement between 4 RAR (Cdo) and the 4 RAR Museum Foundation (the Foundation) regarding management of the 4 RAR Historical Collection (the Collection).

4 RAR (Cdo) Responsibilities

- 4 RAR (Cdo) agrees to the following support:
- recognition of Foundation members as Commonwealth Employees for the purposes of compensation if injured when performing duties in relation to the Collection;
- use by the Foundation of unit vehicles within the confines of Holsworthy Barracks for movement of stores and equipment related to the Collection;
- assistance by members of 4 RAR (Cdo) (work parties) to achieve specific requirements, on request.
- storage of the Collection's weapon holdings until permanent secure storage facilities are developed for the Collection;
- maintenance and repair of standing structures within the Foundation's allocated area; and
- accommodation and rations for Foundation members, who reside outside the metropolitan area, when attending meetings or undertaking two or more consecutive days' work in respect to the Collection.

Foundation Responsibilities

- The Executive Committee agrees to:
- manage the Foundation as a public non-profit company in accordance with the requirements of the Australian Securities and Investments Commission;
- manage the historical collection in accordance with the Army History Unit's guidelines;
- keep HQ 4 RAR (Cdo) informed of all matters relevant to the efficient and effective management of the historical collection;
- comply with extant procedures for access to Holsworthy Barracks; and

e. comply with 4RAR(Cdo) extract safety management policy.
